INFORMATION:

WHAT IS SAMTC

South Africa's Amateur Modelling & Talent Competition is for males & females and is dedicated to the advancement of modelling and talent through competitive events, the establishment of professional ethics and the standardization of training. The competition is open to all amateur models and/or those engaged in the performing arts, regardless of their affiliation with any other modelling or talent association or pageant.

WHO MAY COMPETE IN SAMTC

Any amateur may enter SAMTC

REGISTRATION FEE

A R350.00 Registration Fee is required to participate in the SAMTC National Finals.

Each modelling or talent category entered is an additional R25.00. Spectator fees are R100.00 per person per day.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Events have been scheduled so that contestants may participate in every category, especially those who are trying for the overall MODEL OF THE YEAR or TALENT OF THE YEAR awards.

MODELING & TALENT SOLO AGE DIVISIONS

Competitive modelling and talent events will be broken into the following age divisions:

Categories:

Females: 4-6 / 7-9 / 10-12 / 13-15 / 16-19 / 20+ / Mrs

Males: 4-8 / 9-12 / 13-17 / 18+

CATEGORY AWARDS

Official SAMTC awards will be given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each modelling and talent category. In the event that there are less than three (3) participants in a category, the judges (at their discretion) may withhold giving a 1st place award if they feel the participant is not qualified for such an award.

OVERALL "SAMTC MODEL OF THE YEAR" AWARDS

To qualify for the overall modelling awards, a participant must have entered the Party wear category and any other four modelling categories of their choice (minimum: 5 modelling categories). Points from the required category and the four highest points from other categories entered (you may enter as many categories as you desire) will be tabulated in the following manner: Each 1st place - 3 pts; each 2nd place - 2 pts; each 3rd place - 1 pt. The participant accumulating the highest number of points in each age division will be awarded the official "SAMTC MODEL OF THE YEAR" National title, Sash, trophy & crown. (A "model-off" in the garment of your choice will be held in the event of a tie).

(Should there be in excess of 30 contestants in any particular age category a cash prize of R1000,00 will be applicable to the winner of that category)

OVERALL "SAMTC TALENT OF THE YEAR" AWARDS

To qualify for the overall talent awards, a participant must enter a minimum of three (3) solo talent categories. The highest points from 3 talent categories entered (you may enter as many categories as you desire) will be tabulated as follows:

Each 1st place - 3 pts; each 2nd place - 2 pts; each 3rd place - 1 pt. The participant with the highest number of points in each age division will be awarded the official "SAMTC TALENT OF THE YEAR" title, Sash, trophy & crown. (In the event of a tie, those making the tie will perform again in order to break the tie).

(Should there be in excess of 30 contestants in any particular age category a cash prize of R1000,00 will be applicable to the winner of that category)

METHOD OF ADJUDICATION

SAMTC modelling and talent competitions are NOT BEAUTY CONTESTS; however, good grooming and overall appearance will be taken into consideration.

Modelling will be judged on: 1) Posture & Body Alignment; 2) Walk & Movements; 3) Interpretation of Garment; 4) Presentation; 5) Composition of Routine.

Talent will be judged on: 1) Appearance; 2) Composition of Routine; 3) Variety & Difficulty; 4) Execution; 5) Presentation

RULES & REGULATIONS - MODELLING

Models choose their own garments. Props and accessories may be used; however, they must be small enough to be carried during the presentation. Modelling will be executed as follows: - All garment categories will be "runway modelling" and the participant will be expected to show proper entrance and exit, a basic pivot or other turn and the necessary detailing and interpretation of the garment. Smoothness, flow (fluid motion), showmanship and sales ability are all important attributes for a good model.

MODELLING PROCEDURE

SAMTC is "free style" and there is no set modelling pattern or style.

DESCRIPTION OF MODELING CATEGORIES - ALL AGES

PARTYWEAR / COCKTAIL - (Required Modeling Category)

Females - The correct dress for this division will be short or Knee-length dress that would be appropriate for the participant if she were attending a party or social event. -

Males - cocktail wear means suit and tie, or coat and tie.

INTERVIEW WEAR - Outfit should be one which would be worn for a personal interview, etc. Suggested styles of clothing would be a casual dress, skirt and blouse, slacks with jacket, etc.

SWIMWEAR - Any type of swimsuit selected by the participant. Swimsuit selection should be in good taste and appropriate for the age division of the participant. In this category a swimsuit "cover-up" may be worn and removed during modelling but is not required.

CASUALWEAR - The participant should select a garment that reflects a casual or very informal mood. Suggested styles are sundress, pant suits, skirts with blouse. An outfit that one might wear while shopping or attending a casual brunch.

FORMALWEAR / BALL GOWN - Long or knee-length evening gown which would be worn to a formal evening occasion such as a wedding, formal party, ball, etc.

SLEEPWEAR/LOUNGEWEAR - Pyjamas, nightshirt or night gown is appropriate attire for this modelling category. NOTE: In this category the participant may wear and remove a robe during the modelling presentation, however, it is not required.

WESTERN WEAR - The appropriate wardrobe could be as practical as blue jeans and boots or as whimsical as a "rhinestone cowboy" look. The judges will be looking for any outfit, serious or fun, that evokes a "western wear" look.

PHOTOGENIC - Judged on photogenic qualities from a photograph. Bring photo on day of competition (DO NOT MAIL). Photo may be black & white or colour. Photos will be returned. Judged on photographic beauty, mood or expression and quality of photograph.

SPECTATOR TICKET PACKAGE PLANS

Participants will receive a participation number.

All spectators (including parents) must either purchase an SAMTC Ticket Package Plan for R100.00 which allows spectator access on the 10th & 11th or alternatively a charge of R100,00 per person per day will be charged if the Ticket Package Plan is not purchased in advance.

The Ticket Package Plan includes a Spectator Badge which allows "walk-through admittance to all events. Package Plans must be pre-ordered on the Entry Form and will give you access to both days - 10th & 11th June

RULES & REGULATIONS - TALENT COMPETITION

Participants choose their own garments. Props and accessories may be used; however, they must be small enough to be carried during the presentation.

SOLO TALENT COMPETITION

Entrants may enter as many talent categories as desired, however they may NOT enter more than one talent act within a category. Presentations should be about 1 1/2-minutes in length but may **NOT EXCEED 2:00 minutes**. Hand props, but NO SCENERY, are allowed. Having your own piano & accompanist or pre-recorded accompaniment is recommended. A cd player and microphone (lavalier, stand or hand mike) will be provided. Any other equipment is the participant's own responsibility. No type of knife act or special lighting effects will be allowed. Should the contestant use 'fire' in their routine they will be held responsible for any damage that may be incurred as a result of this fire.

MUSIC

Talent participants must furnish their own music on a CD. Please ensure your name and age is on the cd as well as the cover and only have ONE track on each cd.

The 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners in each category will receive Gold, Silver & Bronze medals providing a minimum of 10 contestants take part in each category alternatively a certificate will be issued. Categories will be joined if less than 10 per category.
